Before and After School Provision

Our care club is Governor-run and staffed by qualified practitioners in a dedicated room. A mixture of adult led and child initiated activities are always on offer within a topic themed approach. Younger children are escorted to/from Nursery or their Classrooms at the start/end of the day.

If your child is 3 years old you are entitled to 15 hours per week free care [Government Funded]. Your child may start our nursery in the term in which they turn 3, however, if they start before their third birthday all provision will have to be paid for until the funding starts in the following term.



Working parents with a 3 and 4 year old may be entitled to 30 hours of funded childcare.
