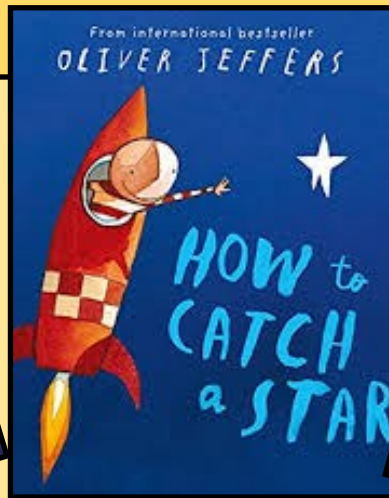


World Space Week

We have made rockets and used non-standard measurements (our feet) to see how far they flew and used ordinal numbers to see who came 1st, 2nd, 3rd.

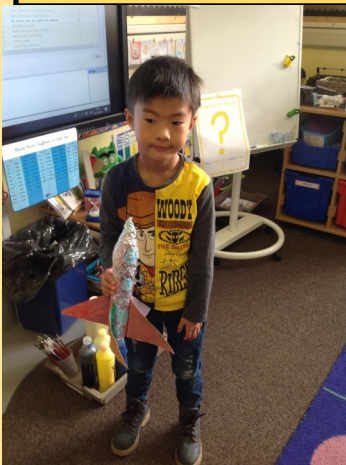


World Space Week
