
#### **School Dinners**

#### World Book Day – Dressing up



Pupils in England will have the choice to take a GCSE examin British Sign Language (BSL) from 2025. BSL is a form of communication using hand gestures and other movements. Pupils, who take the subject, will learn around 1,000 different signs. Fairfield High School (pictured in this week's poster) already runs a successful extracurricular club in response to pupils' interest in learning BSL.
