Nursery

Last week, we welcomed five new children into our class and they have settled in amazingly! We had a fantastic transition week and spent lots of time in the Outdoor Learning Area and enjoyed exploring the Conservation Area. This week, the children in Nursery have been learning about 'People who help us'. We started the week by looking at the emergency services and the children were very excited to learn about being firefighters. We then moved on to learn about the medical services and set up our own hospital and x-ray department. The children dressed up and worked together to be paramedics, doctors, surgeons and nurses. We also looked at the wonderful work that dentists and opticians do and took our special animal friends to the vets! We have also been practising for Sports Day and learnt about why VE Day is important.











Reception

This week in Reception we have continued to look after the chicks and watched them change each day. We have focused on the story of 'The Little Red Hen', the children have enjoyed retelling the story using puppets and writing about it during adult led time. We will continue our learning over the next few weeks finding out about other farm animals and farm machinery.

Year 1

This week year 1 has started lots of new topics, we have started multiplication and division in Maths, relationships in Jigsaw, digital writing in Computing and plant parts in Science. We went on a hunt to find wild plants around school and we found daisies, dandelions, bluebells, and fescue.

We have also had a few lessons on magnificent monarchs in History and year 1 have loved finding out information about kings and queens from the past.







Year 2

Year 2 have had a busy few weeks back at school since the Easter break. We have started a new story in English called 'The Queen's Knickers' written by Nicholas Allan. The children are working their way through a sequence or work to write descriptive piece of work. In Maths, we have started learning about fractions. Children have learnt about halves, quarters and thirds over the last 2 weeks. We enjoyed our wow day linked to Magnificent Monarchs last week. Children completed a timeline of Monarchs and learnt about the role of important kings and Queens.















Year 3

Year 3 has enjoyed another busy week. We have been reading our new class text, 'Cinderella of the Nile', an alternative version of the traditional tale. We have been learning about the main character, 'Rhodopis' and have written a diary entry from her point of view. This story links nicely in with our main topic this term, which is 'ancient civilisations'.

In Maths, we have continued our topic of 'time'. As well as telling the time to the minute, we have been learning how to calculate durations in hours and minutes. In D&T this week we started looking at simple machines. We have learnt that they can make physical jobs easier by changing the strength or direction of a force.

Year 4

We have had a super couple of weeks in Year 4, introducing our new topic 'Ancient Civilisations'! They particularly enjoyed their Art lesson last week, where we studied statues and figurines. The children had fun creating their own poses for their peers to sketch, which consisted of using and practising lots of different skills. Year 4 have been adapting to their lovely, new classroom so well, and I have been really proud of their resilience. They have been so welcoming and I am really looking forward to continue working with them. Thank you Year 4!



Year 5

Year 5 have had a brilliant week. The children worked really hard to learn their lines for our class assembly about the Greek Gods. Parents, and then the whole school, got to watch the play, 'Odyssey at the Museum'. I am very proud of the children and the effort that they put into the performance well done! On Wednesday, we had our Ancient Greek Wow Day. The children got dressed up and learnt about where Greece is located and it's climate. They researched about Ancient Greek Gods and Goddesses and wrote acrostic poems. They did art work, representing Medusa and ended the day by trying lots of Greek foods, such as olives, taramasalata, anchovies, flat bread, houmous and feta cheese.



















Year 6

Y6 have been extremely busy over the last few weeks preparing for our SAT's which begin next week. We have been revising thoroughly and making sure we remember all of our learning from not just the beginning of this year but from every year at primary school. Although it has been tough for the children, they have worked extremely hard to stay focused and try their best at all times. We are so proud of their efforts and wish them enormous luck for next week. We have no doubt they will do us, themselves and you proud!

Leo's Den


