### **Create an Easter Egg competition offers vouchers and a special gift**

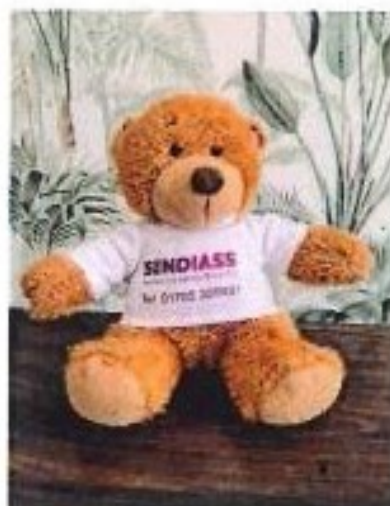
The Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Information Advice and Support Service (SENDIASS) team is currently holding a 'create an Easter Egg' competition.
