Lockdown Procedures



As part of a Staffordshire central directive we have a plan for "lockdowns". Lockdown procedures are important and would be used in response to an internal or external incident which could be a threat to safety of staff and children in the school. Lockdown procedures may be activated in response to any number of situations, these may be:

- 1. A reported incident or disturbance in the local community
- 2. An intruder on the site
- 3. A warning received regarding a local risk of air polution (smoke plume, gas cloud etc)
- 4. A major fire in the vicinity of the school
- 5. The proximity of a dangerous dog roaming close by

In the event of an actual lockdown parents will be notified by a text message as soon as possible.
